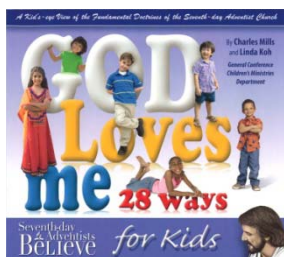
What if the primary mission of the church is *not* to help the family, and the number one priority of the family is *not* to go to church? What if they are *both* designed to work together to show a generation who God is?

When you think Orange, you *rethink* the way you do ministry for children and teenagers.

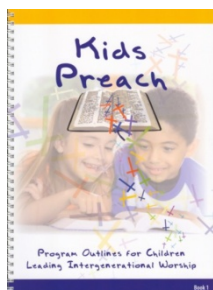

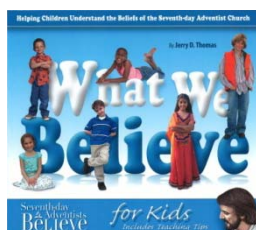
